#### **Dear Applicant**

Please read the instructions before completing the application form.

#### 1. General Instructions

- 1.1 The completed application form must be submitted before 30 September 2020 if you want to be considered for a bursary for 2021.
- 1.2 Only application forms completed correctly, in full and accompanied by the required supporting documents will be considered.
- 1.3 You may scan and email your completed form and supporting documents to apply@studytrust.org.za or fax them to 086 538 1537.
- 1.4 Only applications from South African citizens will be considered.
- 1.5 Please apply timeously for admission for next year to the educational institution of your choice.
- 1.6 Please apply for Financial Aid when you apply for admission at tertiary institutions. For a NSFAS bursary, apply online at www.nsfas.org.za.

- 1.8 An application made on a StudyTrust application form will be considered for all the bursaries we manage. Applicants are advised to apply for as many other bursaries that are not managed by us, as possible. A list of available bursaries can be obtained from Khetha (see 1.6).

#### 2. Selection Criteria

- 2.1 The main criteria used in the selection of successful applicants are <u>financial need</u>, <u>academic potential</u> and <u>career-oriented</u> study programmes. Preference is also given to applicants from rural areas and to female applicants.
- 2.2 Prospective University, University of Technology and College (TVET and Agricultural) students who intend to study full-time, and who have obtained a pass mark in all their subjects, and who intend following career-oriented programmes that are in demand in the labour market, are eligible.
- 2.3 Applicants for tertiary bursaries must please specify as clearly as possible the exact programme of study and the name of the educational institution where you plan to study next year. Study programme changes, after submitting your application form, may lead to the cancellation of a bursary.
- 2.4 StudyTrust's sponsors give preference to applicants intending to study at public tertiary institutions, and only a limited number of bursaries are available for students at private tertiary institutions.
- 2.5 The introduction of the DHET Bursary Scheme administered by NSFAS led to a shift in focus to applicants from households with a combined annual income of between R350,000 and R750,000.

#### 3. Bursary Value

A full-cost StudyTrust-administered bursary or scholarship covers tuition, accommodation; meals; books; equipment; and transport. We also administer top-up bursaries to students receiving DHET bursaries administered by NSFAS.

A copy of the latest audited financial statements or an affidavit declaring monthly income if your parent(s) is/are self-employed. 5.2 5.3 Sworn affidavits if your parent(s) is/are unemployed. 6. A certified copy of a death certificate or an affidavit in the case of deceased parent(s). 7. A certified copy of the divorce certificate if your parents are divorced. 8. If your parents are separated, a sworn statement from one of them confirming their separation and stating the monthly monetary contribution made by the parent not living with the applicant.

- 5.1 Receipt: You will receive Email confirmation upon receipt of your completed application form. All properly completed applications received will be considered.
